#### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The requested funds will enhance Stay In Step's rehabilitation services, with advanced equipment like a HydroWorx therapy tank, hyperbaric chamber, and red-light therapy tools to improve mobility, reduce pain, and accelerate recovery. Facility upgrades, including construction, air conditioning replacement, and accessibility improvements, will create a safe environment. Funding for staff salaries will expand capacity, provide personalized care, and improve outcomes, empowering independence.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will enhance recovery for individuals with spinal cord and brain injuries through specialized therapies, including aquatic therapy with a HydroWorx tank, hyperbaric oxygen therapy, red light therapy, and advanced tools like compression boots, electrical stimulation, and a Galileo vibration plate. Funding will also support staff salaries to expand personalized care, and facility upgrades for a safe, accessible environment. These improvements will help patients regain independence and improve their quality of life.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The project will provide specialized rehabilitation services for individuals with spinal cord injuries, brain injuries, and neurological disorders. Advanced therapies like HydroWorx aquatic therapy, HBOT, red light therapy, compression boot therapy, electrical stimulation, and vibration plate training will improve mobility, reduce pain, and enhance recovery. Funding for staff and facility upgrades will expand access, improve care, and help patients regain independence and quality of life.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project serves individuals with spinal cord injuries, brain injuries, strokes, and other neurological conditions, including both veterans and civilians in Greater Tampa Bay and beyond. New equipment and expanded staff will enhance Stay In Step's capacity to offer advanced therapies like HydroWorx aquatic therapy, hyperbaric oxygen, and red-light therapy. These upgrades will increase annual patient access, improving outcomes and empowering more individuals to regain mobility and independence.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will enhance rehabilitation for individuals with spinal cord injuries, brain injuries, and neurological disorders, improving mobility, reducing pain, and fostering independence. Advanced equipment like the HydroWorx tank, hyperbaric chamber, and red-light therapy will accelerate recovery. Adding an OTA and two aides will expand therapy access, with outcomes measured through standardized assessments, patient tracking, and satisfaction surveys to ensure impact and optimize success.

The contracting agency may impose penalties, including fee reductions, withheld payments, or liquidated damages for delays or poor performance.
