a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this request is to provide stormwater drainage improvements to Roosevelt and Canal Streets within the City of Tarpon Springs. These stormwater improvements will provide essential drainage to resolve flooding issues that occur even during sunny-day (tidal) flood events and potentially mitigate storm surge impacts.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will support construction of a new stormwater system within the City of Tarpon Springs to provide needed flood control.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A new stormwater system will provide needed flood control in the Roosevelt and Canal Streets area.



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d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The residents and business owners within the Roosevelt and Canal Streets areas would primarily benefit from this project. By installing a backflow prevention device to prevent high tidal conditions from surcharging the storm sewer pipes, it would potentially alleviate backflow in the existing roadways.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome for this project is to reduce the number and/or frequency of flooding events. By doing so, the City aims to reduce the impact of flooding due to extreme high tides, rain events, and storm surge.

If the City of Tarpon Springs fails to meet the deliverables of this funding request, it is expected that the City will repay all or a portion of the funding provided.
