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Community Center will be available for use by the local School District, Nassau County Sheriff and Emergency Operations, Hurricane Services Staging, many other non-profit organizations and community events including Rodeos, Concerts, Festivals and a host of other activities. There is no other facility like this in Nassau County. This facility will be ADA compliant.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Strategic Animal Response as shelter for local livestock during evacuations, Mess hall for EOC and Utilities workers during storm prep. Various community activities, Some examples are: Staging Center for Florida Power and Light during disaster prep, Food Drives and Distributions, Job Fairs, Health Fairs, Mental Health Awareness, Reley4Life, Toys4Tots, Sheriff's Charities Fund Raisers, etc.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The citizens of Nassau County and Northeast Florida including Baker, Clay, St Johns and Duval counties. We currently serve over 100,000 visitors per year. That number will increase tremendously once this project is completed. This facility will directly influence and promote FFA and 4H programs through it's use (at no cost) for various livestock and horticultural training. Other educational activities will be provided by the local Extension Office that is co-located on our property.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project, once completed, will provide a venue for community events, activities and enjoyment. Success will be measured by attendance and in aid to local EOC staging.
