### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The off grade railroad crossing will provide safe passage over an active rail line. This will alleviate current traffic, unsafe traffic, and emergency response times in the area and will lead to federal funding for the construction of an off grade rail crossing. Funds will allow for alignment of the road and set the foundation for seeking federal funding sources. The Acree Road Extension has been added to the City of Jacksonville's Mobility Plan to allow for another local funding source. This is a public-private partnership between the city and a local developer.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The design and permitting of the roadway alignment and off grade crossing in coordination with the City of Jacksonville and FDOT.

The current citizens have been advocating for an overpass from the city since 2008 and have identified traffic safety concerns and delays in response from Emergency Services as significant negative impacts to their quality of life.
