a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The completion of a new U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) office at the Port of Fernandina. The current building has been deemed inoperable, and without a new building CBP could cease operations in Fernandina and the Port would lose its "Port of Entry Designation".

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The port of entry designation allows the Port of Fernandina with CBP to carry out customs and immigration operations including conducting inspections, processing immigration documents, and collect duties and taxes.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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By keeping the Port of Entry designation, the Port can continue to be an economic driver in Northeast Florida and be used as a tool to attract more businesses and high paying jobs to the region.
