Consists of the acquisition, home demolition, and septic system removal of the most vulnerable properties within the Thomas Creek basin. This project removes septic tanks from the headwaters of Nassau River - St. Johns River Marshes Aquatic Preserve, and repetitive loss properties from the State of Florida thus having a positive impact on property insurance liabilities. Four parcels have been purchased and are in the process of being returned to natural conditions.
