a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To replace facility and habitat maintenance equipment, specifically, two (2) John Deere Gator ATVs, one (1) Bobcat UW56 Tool-Cat including tool attachments, two (2) Central A/C units, two (2) gas powered pressure washers w/100 ft. hoses, 50 long-range 2-way radios. These items are critical to the maintenance and functioning of our facility, grounds and animal habitats as well as the functioning of our Manatee Rescue Team.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Our facility and natural marine habitat are unique and vital assets for our dolphin and sea lion family, our programs, our community and the state. Maintaining these assets requires that we replace essential equipment as it deteriorates and becomes unusable. This funding will enable DRC to continue to maintain and improve our facility and animal habitats for the benefit of our animals, visitors and students as well as manatees in distress who will be rescued by our Manatee Rescue Team.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This funding will enable us to continue to maintain our facility and animal habitats, ensuring our ability to provide memorable, life-changing programs for individuals, families and students from Monroe County, all of Florida, the country, and around the world. It benefits our nation's wounded military veterans and their families who come to DRC to participate in our Wounded Warrior programs. In addition, our Manatee Rescue Team assesses and rescues manatees in distress in our area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Dolphin Research Center is a Florida Keys destination with over 70,000 visitors annually, including individuals, families, veterans and students from all walks of life and all areas of the Keys, the state of Florida, the country and the world.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Replacing these critical equipment items will ensure our continued ability to: Provide the best possible home for our dolphin and sea lion family; Continue groundbreaking cognitive and behavioral research with dolphins; Aid manatees in distress through our Manatee Rescue Program; Enhance the lives of children with Special Needs and Make-a-Wish participants through our Dolphin Pathways program; Support Wounded Warrior Soldier visits to Dolphin Research Center to benefit our nation's military men and women and bring much-needed joy into the lives of wounded soldiers and their families. Measured by comments and reviews, and increased number of visitors.

Since the project is being initiated by DRC for facility and habitat maintenance best practices reasons there are no penalties to add to the contract.
