This project will improve safety for vulnerable roadway users by providing sidewalks on two corridors connecting to a public education campus that includes an elementary school, a middle school, and a high school.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Pasco County will construct this project to improve the quality of service to all who travel along these roadways.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will receive safe sidewalks.

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d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is eastern Pasco County residents, especially students and their families.

Over 4,000 students travel these corridors on an average weekday. All of them, their families, and over 50,000 area residents will benefit from this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Fatal and serious injury crashes along the corridor will be prevented - measured via MPO safety targets annually. Traffic flow will operate efficiently along commuting corridors for these schools due to provision of separate facilities for walking, biking, and driving - measured via Pasco Traffic Ops analysis of roadway operations.
