a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The appropriation will help finish the construction and improvements of the 15,000 square foot Seafarers' House center located within Port Everglades (PEV). By completing this facility, Seafarers' House will be better equipped to provide the necessary services and amenities to the Port Everglades workforce and seafarers, including providing access to a café, convenient store, shipping services, recreational space, wire transfer services, and meditation and counseling spaces.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



Seafarers' House services are available to Port workers as well as seafarers, including a café, convenient store, shipping services, recreational space, wire transfer services, and meditation and counseling spaces. Port Everglades generates more than \$26.5 billion worth of business activity annually and supports 10,778 direct local jobs and 192,688 jobs statewide. The funds will complete the final construction plans for the 15,000 square foot Seafarers' House community center this is open to seafarers and the Port Everglades community.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Services are open 7 days a week for all Port workers and seafarers, and include free access for mental health services from counselors and clergy, meditation space, free WiFi services, a café, convenient store, shipping services, recreational space, and wire transfer services. In times of crisis or emergencies we also provide immediate support and resources to affected port workers.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Seafarers, the "invisible essential workers," are the target population. There are approximately 750,000 crew visits each year in Port Everglades. Maritime transport depends on the 1.6 million seafarers who operate the world's merchant ships, which carry about 90% of global trade by volume, including most of the world's food, energy, and medical supplies. Most crew members come from countries where unemployment is high and work hard for what our society considers low wages. They leave their families for up to a year to support them. Their jobs are dangerous. Hours are long; they enter multi-cultural, multi-lingual environments, and because they live where they work, they do not have much.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

Improvements to the environment and facility will benefit the Port Everglades workforce. A completed and improved facility will provide amenities and services that will increase morale, productivity and mental health for the workforce and seafarers. Our center provides a space for rest, recreation, and social interaction, helping to alleviate the stress and isolation experienced by many maritime workers. An increase in participation of services is measured through transportation logs, recording transport from ships to center.
