Manatee Technical College will offer career certificate workforce training in Aviation Airframe Mechanic and Aviation Powerplant Mechanic. Instruction will prepare students for FAA license exams for Airframe and/or Powerplant ratings, in alignment with FAA Part 147 requirements for AMT schools.

Target population is high school, college, and economically disadvantaged persons. The number of students expected to be served per year is 60 - 100.
