13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Existing drainage structures that have become less efficient over time due to weather, vegetative growth, construction, and normal wear and tear will be rehabilitated to minimize pooling water in residential areas. Optimized drainage structures will allow for more consistent drainage into designated areas, and will allow for more efficient maintenance by city staff in the future. Integrity of structures such as roads, sidewalks, and residential driveways will be prolonged.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Throughout the construction process, and upon completion, San Antonio Public Works Department will continue with regular maintenance of the rehabilitated structures to ensure the structures remain operation and maintained to mitigate damage.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will benefit from enhanced stormwater structures. Residents in the target areas will see reduced risk of damage to personal property due to standing water. During times of heavy rain, decreased stormwater will collect on public roadways and reduce travel limitations.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the general population of San Antonio residents, not restricted to those residing in the target areas due to the availability of public roadways.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits will include ease of future maintenance of swales and culverts and other structures, along with decreased need for large scale rehabilitation projects or repairs to roads or other structures as a result of standing stormwater. Measurement of outcomes can be determined by comparing annual maintenance costs in the target area over time. Additional verification of successful drainage flows may be able to be verified through studies performed by the city's retained engineering consultant, with additional data available in the form of engineered plans and topographical maps of the area.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables as outlined in agreements between the city and other parties associated with the project will lead to penalties such as withholding of payments. Anticipated deadlines would be agreed upon prior to commencement of work on a project to ensure compliance, along with requirements to submit proof of progress throughout construction.
