The Town of Cutler Bay ("Town") is requesting \$1,000,000 for Capital Improvements to improve the stormwater management system and treat runoff pollutants in the SW 207 Street and SW 85 Avenue corridors. The shovel-ready project aims to improve the existing drainage system by installing an additional 3,600 linear feet of exfiltration trench underneath the roadway, adding supplementary catch basins; replacing some existing catch basins, and installing additional supplementary exfiltration trenches and pipes.

13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project aims to improve water quality and mitigate flooding in a hazard area.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The shovel-ready project aims to improve the existing drainage system by installing an additional 3,600 linear feet of exfiltration trench underneath the roadway, adding supplementary catch basins; replacing some existing catch basins, and installing additional supplementary exfiltration trenches and pipes. The existing catch basins will be modified to provide sediment traps and pollution retardant baffles to protect the French drains. Additional French drains, catch basins, and/or manholes will provide water quality and water quantity treatment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The proposed project reduces the flood risk for the residents of Cutler Bay and protects the Town's evacuation routes. Since incorporation, the Town has adopted higher regulatory standards and, currently, adheres to the base flood elevation standard, plus 1ft. above. Due to the efforts of the Public Works Department, the Town is currently rated by FEMA as a Community Rating System 3 which provides flood insurance policy holders in the Town with a 35% discount on their premiums.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Town of Cutler Bay's population is 43,958 (Census 2022), this project supports the entire community.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Cutler Bay is bordered on the West by Biscayne Bay National Park and the Biscayne Bay Wetlands. In our efforts to protect the Bay, the Town has implemented a series of best management practices related to stormwater treatment. The Town consistently educates the community about water pollution due to stormwater runoff and regularly maintains the Town's streets and drainage systems. All Capital Improvement Projects include improved treatment trains that will ultimately reduce pollutant loads to Biscayne Bay by 89% or greater.
