a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The requested funds will support the fourth annual Hometown Heroes Parade and Festival, an event dedicated to honoring law enforcement, first responders, and frontline workers. The goal is to celebrate their sacrifices and achievements while fostering community unity. Additionally, the event raises awareness about the mental health challenges faced by first responders, promoting resources and support for their well-being. These funds will ensure a successful, impactful event.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will contribute directly to the development of a robust community event with a direct county-wide impact. The items being provided to the public range from assistance for children/youth interactive activities and games based solely on the fields of law enforcement and front line workers to that of performances and public photos with everyday heroes

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Organizations that provide help to those that need mental support and assistance specifically for fire and police officers which experience trauma. Support for public that need help with small business programs. Multiple organizations that assist with family services. Neighborhood resource units accessible to public on site and much more.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This community event is County-wide, therefore, for all 2.8 million residents of Miami-Dade County will be able to attend. Expected over 10,000+ attendees.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Offering hands-on learning experiences that teach children and adults about the vital roles of first responders in our community. These interactive exhibits and demonstrations will provide real-world lessons on safety, teamwork, and civic responsibility, enhancing traditional classroom education. The participation of at least 300 students in these educational activities, increasing their knowledge. Surveys distributed to students, parents, and educators, assessing the knowledge gained about public safety and first responder roles. Additionally, tracking participation in educational activities will provide quantitative data, while follow-up discussions with local schools will evaluate how students apply what they learned.
