### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The facility's main goal will be to serve as a community resource during natural disasters by providing space for local governments to safely store equipment and manpower during the event. It will be used by FPL to stage the necessary equipment and manpower to restore power in the community. It will also provide space for the local community to enjoy the fair as well as other events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The fair has an agreement with FPL for storm staging and restoration as well as a lengthy history of doing such. Also, the facility will hold the Sarasota County Fair with over 120,000 residents visiting. During the year, the Fair offers it facilities to promote Sarasota with concerts, commercial activites,, expanded ability to increase sports tourism.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The ability to stage emergency teams and utility workers will provide a direct service to the citizenry at large by restoring servies in a quick and timely manner. It can be used to support regional as well as statewide disaster response. The facility will provide a secure environment for the youth to house and display their fair projects.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the community at large. It will serve over 500,000 people annually through the fair, activites and storm related services.

The benefit of the project is to have a facility that withstand a natural disaster, serve the community in the response as well as provide a center piece for the Sarasota County Fair. The methodology by which this outcome will be measured will be by the increased utilization and economic impact in Sarasota.
