This includes debris clean up and other natural disaster preventative and post clean up/relief activities. Replacement of unsafe structures which subject Town workers to hazardous working conditions. It will also be put towards preparing a location for new structures which can be used for proper storage of new equipment, to maximize the equipment's life. Improved lawn and landscaping equipment.

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Purchase of new heavy equipment and machinery (dump truck, back hoe are examples). Purchase of new structures for work spaces and storage, clearing of new location to place new storage/work structures. Fencing of cleared area to protect equipment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Debris clean up and other natural disaster preventative and post clean up/relief activities. General obstacle removal and clearing services for Town residents. Improved landscaping maintenance to upkeep appearance and cleanliness of Town.

The approximately 650 or so residents of the Town of Fort White. This project will benefit the entire Town and all residents in the ways mentioned above.
