a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Safe and cost-efficient transportation of shelter and other program youth to and from schools and other events. While CDS' current vehicles in-service at its three CINS/FINS shelters are maintained and safe for the intended purposes, they are reaching the end of their useful lives for transporting youth and should be replaced.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The acquisition of four new passenger vans will entail the replacement of four existing vans, to be followed by routine maintenance and the creation of a depreciation schedule. The four replaced vans will be surplused, with any funds generated to be applied to CDS' programs in support of the children, youth, families, and communities served in 11 North Florida counties.
