The City of Aventura's objective is to prevent crime by developing and establishing an information and intelligence network. This network will gather data from multiple sources, integrate, evaluate, analyze, and disseminate the information, enabling timely and effective actions.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The RTCC will enable the City to swiftly and efficiently identify individuals with malicious intent, whether they are planning, in the act of, or have already committed a crime. This will allow the City to prevent or immediately halt criminal activities, thereby reducing crime rates.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The RTCC will enable the City to swiftly and efficiently identify individuals with malicious intent, whether they are planning, in the act of, or have already committed a crime. This will allow the City to prevent or immediately halt criminal activities, thereby reducing crime rates.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project includes approximately 40,000 residents of the area and around 30 million visitors. The Real Time Crime Center aims to enhance safety and security for both the local community and the vast number of tourists and visitors who come to the City each year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The anticipated benefits of the RTCC include reducing crime, lowering response times, and identifying persons of interest. The success of the RTCC can be measured through several key performance indicators: 1) Crime Rate Reduction; 2) Response Time; 3) Identification of Persons of Interest; 4) Incident Resolution Time; 5) Public Safety Perception; and 6) Technological Utilization.

Performance bonds will be incorporated into the service contract, ensuring strict deadlines for delivery and specific deliverable items.
