The City is approaching 85% concurrency of its wastewater treatment facility and desires to set up an industrial pretreatment wastewater program. The City has contracted a consultant to develop a master plan for its wastewater facility for projected 20-year demands to include scope of services necessary to develop an industrial pretreatment program and a comprehensive assessment of reclaimed water use within the City. This funding request specifically covers the cost of this consultant work.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The contracted engineering consultant will be compensated for performing the work mentioned above and producing the studies / plans mentioned above.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This work will allow the City to effectively plan for future resident and business growth to ensure concurrency is maintained for wastewater infrastructure.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents and businesses of the City of Alachua. The current resident population is estimated at approximately 11,000 people while anticipated population in 20 years is one of the core goals of this study (but is anticipated to be roughly between 15 - 25,000 people), and there are currently approximately 650 local businesses.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This work will allow the City to effectively plan for future resident and business growth to ensure concurrency is maintained for wastewater infrastructure. The outcome will be measured by a list of deliverables agreed to between the City and consultant that includes the work mentioned above.
