a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the project is to complete construction of storm water management infrastructure in the vital downtown district of the island. The storm water improvements include additional collection, conveyance, and BMPs to treat storm water runoff. Goals include improved environmental preservation and protection, contaminant reduction, flood control, and disaster mitigation

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Appropriated funds will be utilized for costs associated with the construction of storm water improvements.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Appropriated funds will be utilized for costs associated with the construction of storm water improvements with improved environmental preservation and protection, contaminant reduction, flood control, and disaster mitigation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Prior to Hurricane Ian, about 6,000 full-time residents lived on the Island with approximately 60,000 seasonal residents and 1 million annual visitors all of which these improvements aim to serve.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The proposed stormwater mprovements are anticipated to improve environmental preservation and protection, contaminant reduction, flood control, and disaster mitigation.

Construction of stormwater infrastructure will protect the public by improving water quality, reliability, system pressures and flows through the replacement of old, deteriorating pipes. Proposed stormwater improvements are anticipated to also improve flooding conditions along Estero Blvd which is the Town's main evacuation route.

Measuring outcomes can be achieved through the appropriate permitting agencies and by the Town, as well as decreased flooding levels to the Town's Level of Service Goals.
