Specifically, state funds will go to site preparation, establishing utilities, water, sewer, drainage infrastructure, and other civil work to support this state-of-the-art facility, which aims to be a gathering place for artists, performers, and audiences, providing a space for creativity, education, and collaboration.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The construction of a 74,000 square-foot Performing Arts Center with featured components: grand theater, a black box theater, a culinary learning lab, classrooms, and outdoor venues.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Theatrical performances, STEM and culinary programs, community art programs, and general services.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population City of Miami Gardens and the greater South Florida communities and visitors. Aiming to serve more than 50,000 people the first three years after opening with performances, programs, and general services. Expect growth of five percent each year thereafter.
