Establish a Workforce Education Center (WEC) to provide education and economic development opportunities for Eastern Hills. Co. The facility will mediate critical instructional space shortages and function as a comprehensive training center for high wage careers in the healthcare, business, and technology fields.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The center will provide workforce training and job placement services for high wage occupations, as well as a space for large-scale training and professional development opportunities for local industry. The center will offer a full scope of student services, including advising, financial aid, veterans' services, counseling and career resource.

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The center will be a multi-function, multi-use space for instruction, workforce training, local stakeholder development, and community events and programming. The center will also serve as a hub for high-value, non-profit agencies to increase public access to services like job placement, food and nutrition support, and childcare.
