a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Miami Lakes Drive, also known as NW 154th Street, is one of the Town's major thoroughfares providing east to west transportation access for road users. The purpose of the Project is to reduce traffic congestion on NW 154th Street (Miami Lakes Drive) from nearby shopping centers, restaurants, hotels, schools, and SHS SR826 on ramps. The goal of the Project is to construct modification to the existing turn lane from NW 154th Street west bound to NW 77th Court south bound to reduce traffic congestion and enhance traffic flow.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities and services to be provided include the design, permitting, and construction modification to the existing turn lane from NW 154th Street west bound to NW 77th Court south bound. The Project will reduce traffic congestion on NW 154th Street (Miami Lakes Drive) from nearby shopping centers, restaurants, hotels, schools, and SHS SR826 on ramps.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to be provided to the citizens and general public of road users include reduced traffic congestion and improved transportation conditions on one of the Town's main thoroughfares NW 154th Street/Miami Lakes Drive and SHS SR826 on ramps.

Target population served by this project are Miami Lakes' citizens and the general public of road users traveling on the Town's major thoroughfare NW 154th Street/Miami Lakes Drive and SHS SR826 on ramps.

Expected benefits include improved transportation conditions, increased traffic flow, and reduced traffic congestion on one of the Town's major thoroughfares and SHS SR826 on ramps. Outcome will be measured by field observations and police cameras at site. The Project will create specific contractor engineer, environmental, and consultant immediate job opportunities measured by contractual agreements.
