We seek to provide the City of Live Oak Fire Department with a new fire engine. This new engine will replace our 1991 Pierce Engine, which has a 2-door cab with open rear jump seats. Our 91 Pierce Engine has been in service for 34 years and is beyond ready for retirement. In addition to age, we are seeking a replacement engine for several additional reasons, including safety, emissions, serviceability, reliability, and environmental factors.

This project is targeted to serve all citizens and visitors of Live Oak, FL and surrounding areas.

*Improve physical health by reducing harmful cancer-causing emissions from diesel engines by up to 90%. By replacing our existing 1991 Pierce Engine we will gain an enclosed rear passenger cab, proper seatbelt restraints, and a diesel exhaust fluid system (DEF) to help reduce dangerous and harmful cancer-causing, engine exhaust-emitted chemicals to our firefighters and citizens.

*Preserve natural areas: DEF helps protect forests, wetlands, and other ecosystems by reducing emissions that create smog and acid rain.

*Reduced climate change: DEF helps reduce the amount of gases that cause the greenhouse effect.
