The primary goals of the proposed project on the Florida State University campus are to enhance pedestrian safety and reduce vehicular speeds in high-traffic areas. By redesigning key intersections, adding well-marked crosswalks, and incorporating traffic-calming measures such as speed bumps, raised sidewalks, and narrower lanes, the project aims to create a safer, more accessible environment for students, faculty, and visitors.

**b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?**



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Construction of speed tables, raised pedestrian crossing, a raised intersection, and a mid-block pedestrian crossing along Chieftan Way, by Doak Campbell Stadium and the FSU Circus, and at the intersection of Spirit Way and Chieftan Way.

Improved public safety and roadways for students, faculty, and visitors at Florida State University.
