Franklin County (County) seeks funds to purchase a Pumper/Tanker apparatus which is critical for the safety and fire protection needs of the Alligator Point / St Teresa area. The area lacks dedicated water sources creating a major operational difficulty for the department. Currently we do not have the necessary apparatus with sufficient water capacity or pumping ability to sustain operations during large scale fires. Without a pumper/tanker, the ability to effectively respond to and mitigate large fires is severely limited.
