a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds will be used to mitigate against flood damage and improve overall water quality by raising seawalls and transitioning some seawalls to living seawalls. During 2024, the city experienced three storm events that overtopped existing seawalls due to tidal surges. Vulnerability Assessment identified a large volume of seawalls that need to be raised. Funds would support initial design and construction efforts to raise several City of Clearwater seawall locations.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Develop design for raising seawall at several city locations using both traditional seawall and living seawall. Develop standard designs and specifications that can be used by residents to raise their seawalls. Construction of elevated seawalls at several city locations using both traditional and living seawall designs for future evaluation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents living in low-lying areas that are impacted by storm surges and excessive tidal elevations.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Mitigation against flooding caused by seawall overtopping. Flood losses can be evaluated against similar storm surges. Nutrient reduction from living seawalls can me sampled for assessment.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Clearwater must provide Corrective Action Plan to demonstrate how project will be recovered. Corrective Action Plan to include specific deliverables and penalties if missed. Plan to be briefed to FDEP and updated based on FDEP feedback. Monthly reports on recovery process to be provided to FDEP. Future year appropriations could be reduced or eliminated. Clearwater cost sharing percentage could be increased.
