Engage the 42 remaining Florida school districts, along with the Department of Juvenile Justice, to promote the implementation of the Holocaust Learning Experience while continuing the serve the current 25 school districts.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Gather outcome measures (data) from participating districts demonstrating student knowledge of the Holocaust and how the curriculum fosters student character development through lessons from Holocaust resources. Ensure historically accurate instruction of the Holocaust throughout Florida schools, delivered directly into the classroom with the educators are facilitators of the curriculum resources and not the purveyors of the content. Preserve the testimonies and legacies of Holocaust survivors for ongoing impact on students.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Holocaust standards, mandated by the state legislature, are achieved and consistently delivered throughout the entire Florida's public education system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Students in Florida's Public School System, grades 5 to 12, 2 million students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Provide examination of what it means to be a responsible and respectful person, for the purposes of encouraging tolerance in a pluralistic society and for nurturing and protecting democratic values and institutions, including the policy, definition, and historical antisemitism, mitigating the language of hate, bias, and prejudice. Student surveys, quizzes, and classroom discussions will be offered and led by the classroom educator. Holocaust Learning Experience will collect, aggregate and analyze the data according to the outcomes set forth by Florida Department of Education.
