### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal and purpose of a new waterfront park will be to enhance social connection, promote access to recreational opportunities, support education and learning, provide services for diverse populations, economic development, improve health and wellness, support safety and crime reduction, and environmental sustainability.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A waterfront park can serve as a valuable community space, offering recreational, environmental, social, and cultural benefits. To meet the intended purpose of funding for such a project, the park should offer a variety of activities and services that align with the needs and interests of the local community, including water sports and activities, land-based recreation, educational events, guiding walking and nature tours, picnic and shelter space, volunteer programs, and promote environmental sustainability.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Kayaking, canoing, paddle boarding and other water sports. Walking and running trails, fishing areas, family-friendly areas, event space for use and rentals, special events, wildlife watching, and other educational outreach programs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is youth to seniors. Recreation programming is versatile and can offer something for everyone regardless of age, socioeconomic status, and access to resources. Existing facilities can serve around 15,000-20,000 citizens per year

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits would be improved community engagement, social cohesion, enhanced physical and mental health, increase access to educational opportunities, economic growth and local business support, promotion of cultural diversity and inclusion, and safety and crime reduction. The methodology for measurement will be tracking attendance at events and programs, participant surveys, participant feedback, business participation records and impact, employment data, police reports, crime statistics, and constant data collection.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

If the contractor fails to meet milestones or deadlines, the contracting agency may extend the project timeline without offering additional funds to the contractor for the delay.
