This grant program allows publicly owned utilities to remove sand and grit from wastewater treatment plants and associated collection systems while the systems remain in operation, resulting in restored wastewater treatment facility capacity and reduced energy costs.

Clean hard-to-reach environments in wastewater collection and treatment systems saving municipalities time and energy costs by maintaining facilities instead of replacing infrastructure.
