### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To strengthen First Tee Tallahassee's ability to deliver on its mission and increase the positive impact it has in the communities served and increase organizational capacity. First Tee is uniquely positioned to impact thousands of area youth to help them uncover their inner strength, self-confidence and resilience through our programs. These funds would be dedicated to benefiting school participants, local educational courses, and, in particular, pediatric and special needs facilities.

First Tee offers a variety of activities designed to engage youth in both golf and character development. These activities are tailored to students' age and skill levels, and they focus on building character, fostering leadership and providing valuable mentorship. Together, these services help our area youth to gain important life skills that prepare them for their futures.

Our direct services for K-8 youth are designed to foster their growth through life skills sessions, character-building activities, community service, leadership development, family and social events, on-course competitions, and golf lessons with practice. Together, these activities help youth develop important life skills and values that will support their success throughout life.

Enhanced Physical Health – Improves coordination, balance, flexibility, and strength through golf-related exercise. Stronger Mental Well-Being – Builds confidence, emotional resilience, and a positive mindset in a supportive environment. Character and Life Skills Development – Instills values like respect, perseverance, and integrity, fostering self-discipline and responsibility. Improved Academic Performance – Incorporates STEM education and life skills training, enhancing problem-solving and goal-setting abilities.

First Tee tracks participation, retention, and engagement using qualitative and quantitative methods to assess student growth. Key evaluations include resiliency surveys, behavioral observations, self-reflection, goal setting, and fitness assessments. These insights refine programs for lasting impact.
