The City of Quincy has continued over the last thirty years to reduce the infiltration within our sewer collection system of fresh storm water by lining sewer lines. The infiltration of storm water into the sanitary sewer lines causes a loss of capacity at our 1.5 MGD at our wastewater treatment facility. Currently, the treatment facility treats .9 MGD. The State of Florida recommends not exceeding 75% of the maximum capacity of the treatment facility. Reducing storm water infiltration preserves capacity for development and defers the cost of constructing a new wastewater treatment facility.
