13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will construct interchange improvements at I-95 and International Golf Parkway using a mix of state and federal funds. The project will improve the safety, capacity and traffic flow of the existing interchange, which is currently deficient to meet the exponential growth of the region. Future connections of the First Coast Expressway to I-95 will add an estimated 50K vehicles daily further compounding all of these issues.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The improvements will increase vehicular safety, reduce delays and decrease congestion on Interstate 95. Lack of congestion will improve conditions for tourists visiting the area including safety. Improved access will provide for greater tourist activity. A more efficient transportation network will generate more economic activity and jobs especially high wage careers in logistics and industrial fabrication.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The improvements will increase vehicular safety, reduce delays and decrease congestion on Interstate 95. Lack of congestion will improve conditions for tourists visiting the area including safety. Improved access will provide for greater tourist activity. A more efficient transportation network will generate more economic activity and jobs especially high wage careers in logistics and industrial fabrication.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project will be all residents and visitors to St. Johns County. In addition all business owners who rely on efficient transportation will experience a reduction of time in the movement of goods which will provide the ability to sustain and increase points of sale to sustain and promote economic stability.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A more efficient transportation network will generate greater economic activity and jobs, especially high wage careers in logistics and industrial fabrication. Lack of congestion will increase and promote tourism, and improve safety with a reduction in motor vehicle accidents. The construction project will immediately create 25 additional jobs. Data will be collected utilizing the appropriate, local, state or federal agency and compared to historical data.
