a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will provide the Jackson County Sheriff's Office with reliable, P25-compliant, interoperable radio communications. This will improve coverage for coordination within the county, across the region, and with state law enforcement and emergency services during natural disasters, man-made crises, and other critical incidents. Additionally, the upgraded communications will significantly improve officer safety and enable more effective mutual aid support to surrounding areas.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Services provided by the implementation of this project include continued, reliable radio communication services to ensure the Jackson County Sheriff's Office is able to quickly and accurately provide emergency response services to the county and to provide mutual aid to surrounding areas.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Once completed, the upgraded systems will allow law enforcement in Jackson County to provide accurate and timely response to requests for emergency services.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target populations that will benefits from this project are the residents of Jackson County, local businesses, schools, and visiting tourists.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits provided by the implementation of this project include improved communication for law enforcement with P25-compliant equipment, improving coverage and interoperability, and reduced response times. Outcomes will be measured by tracking response times, incident resolution, and reductions in crime statistics.
