4. Project/Program Description

The Crosstown Connector is a route through the City of Destin which will serve as an alternative to Highway 98 for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians. This alternative connector road will relieve traffic on Highway 98 by creating better traffic flow and increasing safety. The last remaining leg of this alternative route will be ready for construction by summer of 2025. All necessary right-of-way has been purchased and the project is in the permitting stage right now. The new section of roadway will be a two lane facility accompanied by multi-use trails. The City has secured some funding for construction already in the FY25 budget and should be receiving additional funding from the Okaloosa County Tour Development District once the project is ready for construction. The City anticipates a funding shortfall at this time based on cost estimates from the engineer. With this \$3,000,000 allocation from the state the City believes it could secure the remaining funds necessary.

The new roadway will serve citizens with a much needed alternative to Highway 98 as a means to traverse in Destin. The road will improve traffic flow on Highway 98 and reduce travel times for local traffic using the new connector route.
