a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Installation of approximately 29,000-linear feet of 24-inch DI force main to replace the existing 18-inch PVC force main that serves as the effluent disposal line leaving the Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). The proposed 24-inch effluent force main will serve to 1) replace the existing leaking effluent disposal line 2) provide raw wastewater conveyance for existing and future flows from the WWTF 3) relocate teh effluent force main.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The new pipeline will significantly reduce the environmental damage on the Florida aquifer and allow it to recover, prevent saltwater intrusion and ensure residents have safe drinking water for many years.
