#### 13. Program Performance

#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Construction of a boat ramp facility. The Barge Canal Boat Ramp Project is located along the westside of US19 and the northside of the Barge Canal adjacent to the new USCG Station in Citrus County. The project includes the constr of a 400 foot wide ramp, five gangway's with floating docks, restroom, 6 picnic pavilions, landscaping, lighting, 63 car parking spaces, 245 boat parking spaces and associated storm water facilities. SWFWMD and ACOE permits have been secured for the facility.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The boat ramp is proposed to be placed on the Barge Canal which has been noted to be an area less subject to manatee use. By bringing boaters to this ramp will help reduce boaters in more manatee sensitive areas. Boating and boat facilities can help improve mental health by boosting moods with access to natural resources. Construction of the project will allow boaters to utilize the barge canal. The project may increase development potential and retail commerce as the project is along US19. Boat ramps are critical to eco-tourism. When constructed this ramp will provide boaters with direct access to the Gulf.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Construction of a boat ramp facility will include a 400 foot wide ramp, five gangway's with floating docks (with the ability to add 6 more gangways in the future), restroom, 6 picnic pavilions, landscaping, lighting, 63 car parking spaces, 245 boat parking spaces and associated storm water facilities.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

We anticipate the target population to be greater than 800 pleasure and fishing boaters.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Construction of the project will allow boaters to utilize the barge canal which can be measured by collecting ramp use volume.
