The goal of this project is to secure overtime funding for expenses incurred by the Doral Police Department during POTUS/dignitary related protective events when the President of the United States (POTUS) or protected visits the City of Doral and the Trump National Doral Resort. This funding will enable the Department to recover costs associated with providing security support to federal agencies with regards to POTUS/dignitary related details while supporting national security efforts.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Trump National Doral Resort is a focal point within the City of Doral. The venue hosts United States and international federally sponsored dignitary events and draws significant global attention and crowds of protesters and supporters alike. These funds will allow the City of Doral to support POTUS/dignitary details, as needed, within Doral and surrounding the resort area.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

POTUS/dignitary detail overtime funding will provide the community with enhanced public safety measures during POTUS/dignitary visits, ensuring a secure environment for residents, business owners, and visitors. Following multiple recent national security incidents, it is essential that this funding assist in providing the required national security support during POTUS/dignitary related events within the City of Doral.

The target population are the residents, visitors, and business owners within the City of Doral, Florida. The proposed project will support enhanced security measures for approximately 200,000 individuals within the City of Doral, including residents, visitors, business owners, and employees, ensuring a safer and more secure environment for all.

Each detail will be documented via an approved action plan which includes: the background of the operation, recommendations, intelligence/briefing, logistics and equipment needed, and budgetary considerations. Following each event, an after action report will be completed monitoring the outcome.
