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The funds will support Miami Arts Studio 6-12 @ Zelda Glazer (MAS), a magnet school for the performing and visual arts, created due to a lack of access for students talented in the arts. MAS offers a high-quality and extensive academic and arts curriculum encompassing Middle School and High School level programs in visual art, digital art, dance, music, theater, broadcasting, and entertainment law; in addition, MAS hosts a Saturday arts program for local elementary students in grades 3-5.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Miami Arts Studio 6-12 @ Zelda Glazer (MAS) offers a high-quality and extensive academic and arts curriculum encompassing Middle School and High School level programs in visual art, digital art, dance, music, theater, broadcasting, and entertainment law. In addition to our magnet programs in grades 6-8, MAS hosts a Saturday arts program for local elementary students in grades 3-5.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Miami Arts Studio 6-12 @ Zelda Glazer offers a program of academic and artistic studies which shall be available to talented middle school and high school students. These skills are transferable to the cultural capital of Miami-Dade County as well as to the robust visual and performing arts industry workforce. Cultural experiences and performances are offered to the community for no or low cost.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Over 800 elementary, middle and high school students throughout Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits and outcomes of this project include: enriching the cultural experience, improving the quality of education for students, and increasing access for students talented in the performing and visual arts to receive high-level performing arts and entertainment industry-focused educational opportunities. These outcomes will be measured using: documentation of performances, enrollment statistics, competition awards, scholarship awards, college acceptances, program materials, expert contracts, and disbursement/expense reports.
