13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Increase the plant capacity from the existing 932,000 GPD to 1,432,000 GPD; The existing 500,000 gpd ultra filtration train has no back up. Project provides the required 500,000 gpd class one reliability equipment redundancy with a second 500,000 gpd ultra filtration train equipment redundancy. Proper removal and disposal of residuals (i.e., sludges), water conservation and protection of water resources from pollution.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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To seek preliminary engineering, design, permitting, bidding services, project management, administration, engineering during construction and construction services to expand the water treatment in order to provide water quality and capacity.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

To provide reliable, adequate, and quality drinking water to all users. Increased capacity and flows and improved water quality for businesses, i.,e., Love's Truck Stop, Dollar Grocery Store, as well the City of Moore Haven and Glades County residents, government operations (i.e., Sheriff and Health Dept., Emergency Operations Center), existing commercial enterprises - prison.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is citizenry, visitors and residents of City of Moore Haven, Glades County, which is designated as a Rural Area of Opportunity, financially disadvantaged municipality. Target population is greater than 12,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Protection of residents, visitors, the environment from harm with improved water quality, increased capacity and flows; keeping pollution from water resources with proper treatment and disposal methods of residuals in this Rural Area of Opportunity located in the Caloosahatchee & Lake Okeechobee BMAP areas. Meeting Clean Water Act and permitting agencies rules/regulations is achieved with increasing capacity and flows from 932,000 GPD to 1,432,000 GPD.

Contractual will include timelines, milestones, project management, status reports, corrective action plans, etc. to be adhered throughout the project; implementation of corrective action plan, non-payment of invoices until milestones completed.
