13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds from the State will ensure the uninterrupted design and construction of an iconic and innovative museum of science and history on the North Bank of the St. John's River in Downtown Jacksonville. It will be a hub for culture and entertainment, stem learning and Florida story telling. These funds will specifically move the project into the final design and construction phase.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will support the design, engineering, development and construction of the MOSH new facility.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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MOSH will enhance the North bank of Downtown Jacksonville by creating public gathering spaces for lifelong learning and experiential education, deliver immersive digital experiences and learning that will shape twenty-first century job skills for tomorrow's workforce, showcase dynamic platforms to engage students, families, and adults and dedicate space for early STEAM learning.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The majority of the funds requested will serve the elderly, economically disadvantaged persons, the developmentally disabled, the physically disabled, preschool students, grade school students, high school students, and university/college students. >800 individuals in the target population are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

MOSH's cultural outreach events will enrich cultural experience. Methodology: MOSH will track the number of events and the overall attendance of their cultural outreach events. We will survey attendees, members, and guests to gain feedback and insight on the guest experience. MOSH's public/private school partnerships and field trip initiatives will improve the quality of education. Methodology: MOSH will track the number of events and the overall attendance of the events. We will survey attendees, members, and guests to gain feedback and insight on the guest experience. MOSH will increase tourism, and economic activity in Duval County. Methodology: MOSH will engage with VISIT Jacksonville to review tourism numbers, will track attendance zipcodes, and will survey guests. We will gather city data and measure employment and other financial statistics. The construction project as well as the ongoing operation of the Museum will create an estimated \$2.3 million in new salaries and wages.
