The purpose of this project will be to provide treatment for stabilization of approximately 1,000 LF of canal embankments along the C8 canal between NW 22 Avenue and Railroad Drive, to prevent further loss of land on the affected properties; enhance the safety of residents, increase property values, and help improve the water quality in our canals.

Construct embankment improvements along canals adjacent to residential properties

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Restore eroded land on properties, protection of homes, safety, securing properties and livelihoods, increase livability of neighborhoods and enhancing the quality of life
