a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose of the requested funds is to cover the architectural, engineering, and land development costs required to complete the construction of a new Police Training Center which will include a firearms range. This facility will enhance training capabilities, improve officer readiness, and ensure the department is equipped to handle evolving public safety challenges. The funds will address rising construction costs and ensure the facility meets the current and future needs.

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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The funding will provide citizens with improved public safety through enhanced officer training. The new Police Training Center, including a firearms range, will ensure officers are better prepared for high-pressure situations, leading to safer interactions with the public. This investment will foster a more skilled police force dedicated to serving and protecting the community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

A new police training center in Riviera Beach would benefit both law enforcement officers and the local community. Officers frequently interact with the elderly, individuals with mental health challenges, economically disadvantaged residents, students, at-risk youth, and drug offenders. Enhanced training equips officers to prevent and respond to crime more effectively, make better decisions under pressure, and reduce the likelihood of excessive force, ultimately fostering a safer community.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

The benefit would be measured by tracking reductions in crime rates, improvements in response times, and fewer useof-force incidents. Additionally, officer performance in training exercises and feedback from community members on safety perceptions can provide further insights into the effectiveness of the training center in protecting the public.
