13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Our mission is to support and assist our Veterans with the physical, mental and emotional scars of their military service. PTSD, anxiety, traumatic brain injury, chronic pain and inflammation; these are only some of the burdens borne by our nation's Heroes. Our services provide our Veterans life-changing relief and tremendous improvement in quality of life. Every day, an estimated 22 Veterans lose their battle and take their own lives. We provide an alternative to the traditional "diagnose and medicate" approach taken by so many medical professionals. Our goal is to reach and understand the root causes specific to the issues of each Veteran that walks through our door and create an individual plan to provide real, actual healing for them. In addition to our holistic services, we provide a "by Veteran, for Veteran" environment of familiarity in which so many Veterans find comfort. b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Providing more than twenty services backed by state-of-the-art technology, there is no other facility providing this combination of therapies and this level of personal attention and care to our Veterans. Cryotherapy, red light therapy, halotherapy, EMF pulse, hyperbaric, RIFE and HOCATT just to name a few. Our modalities target and relieve a massive spectrum of issues including chronic pain and inflammation, stress and anxiety, insomnia, chronic allergy relief, high blood pressure and so much more. No two Veterans are the same and so no two Veterans receive the same exact care. We get to know our Veterans, what they did in the military, how they were injured and what stressors they are currently dealing with. Together, we then build a plan and treatment program to provide rapid and lasting relief. All of this is done at absolutely no cost to the Veteran.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Custom, targeted holistic care is provided to our Veterans utilizing any combination of our modalities. We first meet with the Veteran to learn about them. Their background, military experience, preexisting conditions, injuries, illnesses and other causes of pain and suffering.Cryotherapy, red light, hyperbaric chamber, EMF pulse, RIFE, ozone therapy, targeted compression, isolation cryo, halotherapy and more are used in combination to provide relief from pain, inflammation, stress, anxiety, depression, immune deficiencies, allergies, irregular blood pressure and blood sugar, and a myriad of other condition. Providing long-lasting pain relief, while tremendously important, is not the end of the mission. We work to achieve complete wellness in our Veterans. We want to get to the root of the problem and work to provide real healing. Not only physical healing and wellness, but mental and emotional as well. The mission of Cryoeeze22 is to end the current epidemic of Veteran suicide.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

United States Military Veterans. Those that raised their hands and offered their lives to support and defend each one of us. When our service members go off to war, the physical, mental and emotional toll is greater than most can imagine. These heroes come home with scars both clearly visible and impossible to see. Cryoeeze22 works incessantly to improve the quality of life of every American Veteran that walks through our door. We serve Veterans of every age, building a custom treatment plan based on their specific needs. No Veteran is left behind; we continue to serve each Veteran as long as the need continues. Building valuable relationships with these heroes creates a foundation on which their ultimate healing can be built. We aim to provide a minimum of 7,000 Veteran treatments and services per year. Last year, we delivered roughly 2500 sessions, and we will work every day to surpass that number this year and every Veteran that comes in will receive the utmost respect and care.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



There will be a tremendous improvement in the quality of life for our Veterans. These improvements will offer our Veterans an opportunity to lead healthier, happier lives. They will have a greater opportunity to get back to living well and returning to a sense of purpose and belonging. We expect to dramatically reduce the suicide rate within our Veteran community. No Veteran should feel like they can never find relief. That there is no solution to their problems; especially when traditional methods of treatment have seemed to fail them. Our work will afford Veterans a new way forward. A clear path to healing. All Veteran sessions are documented. Each Veteran is listed in computer files and progress is tracked through notes, documentation and when appropriate, photographic evidence of physical healing. Veterans are also continuing to volunteer to provide testimonials in which they speak about how the services provided by Cryoeeze22 have made a difference in their lives.
