a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funding will assist with the building of the new Town Square within The Bay Park Conservancy in Sarasota.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The Bay has a stringent design & construction management process that is approved by the management team, Board of Directors and The Bay Park Improvement Board (which is a combination of elected officials from the City of Sarasota and Sarasota County).

This oversight will lead directly to successful completion of Phase 2 as demonstrated by the success of Phase 1 of the park.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

With the construction of the Town Square, The Bay Park Conservancy will be able to expand the number and type of free events that are provided on a monthly basis. In particular, the Town Square will allow for larger gatherings that include markets, music, health & fitness, and arts & culture.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Bay is truly "One Park for All" and thus serves all ages, races, economic groups, etc. Our visitors and program participants are extremely diverse in their background and interests.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The new Town Square will serve as an anchor for the Cultural District project within Phase 2 of The Bay's master plan. It will help tie together four buildings that are on the Historic Register (The Sarasota Garden Club, Blue Pagoda, Chidsey Library Building and the Sarasota Municipal Auditorium). The Town Square will benefit the community as a whole serving as a central gathering place and expanding the offering of free programs. The increased number of visitors, number of events and type of events will serve as a key metric for success. Other success metrics will be satisfaction surveys and the growth pattern of multi-year annual events.
