The full integration of the existing generator provides backup power for essential security systems, courtrooms, computer servers storing vital records, offices and elevators. It also mitigates cybersecurity risks by providing power to critical systems like firewalls and intrusion detection systems running during a power outage.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The project entails renovation and expansion of the existing switchgear and automatic transfer switch (ATS) located at the courthouse annex building L-1 located at the Collier County Government Center.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The full integration of the existing generator provides backup power for essential security systems, courtrooms, computer servers storing vital records, offices and elevators.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Collier County judges and employees providing services to attorneys, residents and businesses utilizing the courthouse, State Attorneys Office, Clerk of Circuit Court and vital records.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The building and the data storage will be more secure. The backup generator will minimize interruption of services and protect from cyber threats. Provide greater security for the protection of citizens utilizing the court building and vital records.
