a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To expand the Port LaBelle Utility System (PLUS) Water Treatment Plant (WTP) capacity from 1.2 million gallons per day (MGD) to 1.8 MGD in order to provide additional potable water capacity for the PLUS service area which is one of the fastest growing areas in Hendry County. The WTP expansion will include additional ground wells, water treatment equipment, and high service pumps. The funding requested this year would provide for the water treatment equipment and pumps. Additional funding will be needed for the wells.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

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Design, construction, and construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services for the expansion of the PLUS WTP.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The water treatment plant (WTP) improvements will provide additional water plant capacity to accommodate growth in Port LaBelle and as result will increase or improve economic activity in Port LaBelle. Currently the WTP is nearing its current permitted capacity and expansion of the WTP is necessary.
