Services to citizens improved with the new administrative offices that will properly house public safety officers, victim's advocacy, public records, provide civil court services, investigative and patrol services, communications services for all emergency services for the county, an armory, financial and IT services for the Sheriff's Office.

Hardee County, which is a financially disadvantaged community (ch. 62-552, F.A.C.) that is located in a Rural Area of Opportunity (s. 288.0656, Florida Statutes), citizenry, visitors, tourists, business community and surrounding areas. Greater than 27,000 expected to be served.
