Wildland fire engine or brush fire trucks are the vehicles that transports firefighters, necessary equipment and water to respond to wildfires. The trucks are designed and have the ability to drive in rough terrain to respond to a fire or a rescue situation.

Purchase two brush fire trucks adhering to the County's procurement policy and procedures that will replace old, unreliable equipment in order to provide necessary emergency fire suppression services to efficiently serve citizens and the community in this Rural Area of Opportunity.
