### 13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To strengthen and maintain the integrity of critical assets wastewater clay piping in order to protect the general public and the environment from harm from leaks and breakage of wastewater pipes. Protection of life, health and safety of citizenry, property and the environment and improves wastewater management.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

To seek contractual services through the City's procurement policies and procedures for professional sewer lining services.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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Direct services to citizens is protection of life, health and safety by securing the integrity of citywide wastewater old clay pipes with with sewer lining technology to prevent harmful leaks and breakage of sewer pipes that will protect State water resources, the environment, surface water and groundwater.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the City of Bartow which serves as the City seat for Polk County and for Regional, Federal and State offices, agencies, properties and buildings, which are tax exempt creating a reduction of revenue that is needed to adequately serve its citizenry and surrounding communities. It is estimated more than 100,000 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefit is protection of the general public, property and the environment from harm, improved physical health, wastewater management and transportation with reduction of sewer piping failures/leaking, Lining of old clay wastewater pipes strengthens the integrity and extends the life of the critical wastewater infrastructure. Bartow provides critical water and wastewater services for Federal/State/Local government properties, residential and commercial properties serving as the Capital City for Polk County.
