4. Project/Program Description

The Basin IV Stormwater Improvement Project addresses major flooding issues identified in the Basin IV Preliminary Engineering Report, which highlights the area's susceptibility to significant flooding during rainfall events. To mitigate these challenges and improve system capacity, the project includes pipe upgrades with larger-diameter pipes being added along 17th Avenue South. Additional stormwater improvements are planned along 18th Ave South to Gordon Drive and along 21st Avenue South. These enhancements, based on recommendations from the report, are designed to offset flooding events, protect property, and ensure the long-term resilience of the community's stormwater infrastructure.
